a new or slightly used Bible, they are available and free for the taking. They are on the shelf marked "Free Bibles" in the Connection Café. Please help yourself!




Lent Study

Rock City Kids were excited to explore the sacrament of Communion during both services on Sunday, January 6th. The children learned of the importance of bread in the daily lives of those living during Jesus' time. After hearing a monologue of what the Last Supper would have been like for Jesus and his disciples, we talked about how they would have been feeling.
